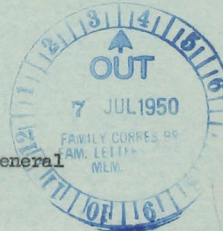
This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

Extract from Non Battle Casualty Report fom 201 File

On the evening of 9th May 45 at 1900 hours Pfc Thompson and a fellow RM were on the banks of the Altz River. They saw a girl fall into the water. In about five minutes the girl appeared upstream from them, calling for help. Pfc Thompson and companion ran down stream, Thompson took off some of his equipment, and dove into the water. The girl pulled his head into the water for a while, and then he emerged towing the girl. After a short time he unloosed the girl, took a few weak strokes, then floated downstream, face down, followed by the unconscious body of the girl. When he unloosed the girl and made these feeble strokes he was approximately 150 feet from his companion Pfc Leonard T Glaum, 33582334 Sv Co 222 nd Inf. Both sides of river banks were searched for four kilometers downstream but no body was found.....

This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspid (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. See reverse side for illustrations.

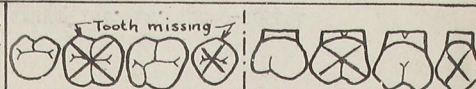

Dear Mrs. Thompson:

I am writing to you with reference to your husband, the late Private Robert J. Thompson.

The remains were recovered by personnel of the American Graves Registration Service from the Altz River near Gendorf, Germany. As identification could not be established at that time, an Unknown designation was assigned pending further investigation, and interment was made in Plot EE, Row 11, Grave 261, in the United States Military Cemetery St. Avold, located twenty-three miles east of Metz, France.

The investigation which has been conducted in an effort to identify his remains is now complete and the identification has been established. I regret that it was not possible to furnish you with this information sooner, however, I feel sure that you realize the necessity of first completing the investigation. With the identification established, the remains have been casketed and are being held pending instructions from the next of kin regarding final interment, either in a permanent United States Military Cemetery overseas or for return to the United States.

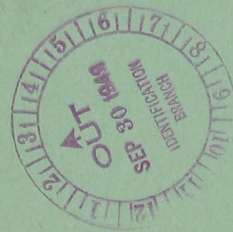

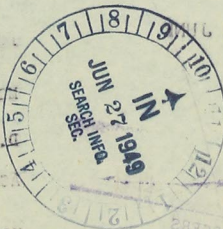



On the evening of 9th May 1945, Pvt Robert J. THOMPSON 39098316 and a companion from the same organization; 222nd Infantry Regiment were on the banks of the Altz River, Germany. They saw a girl fall into the water and in about five minutes the girl appeared upstream from them calling for help. Pvt THOMPSON took off some of his equipment and dove into the water. The girl pulled his head into the water for awhile and then he emerged towing the girl. After a short time he released his hold on the girl, took a few weak strokes, then floated downstream face down, followed by the unconscious body of the girl. Both sides of the river banks were searched for about four kilometers but the remains of Pvt THOMPSON were not recovered. Unknown X-545 was recovered from the Altz River near where Pvt THOMPSON was drowned.

Tooth chart for X-545 is in exact agreement with the tooth chart for Pvt THOMPSON. Estimated height of X-545 is in agreement with the height of Pvt THOMPSON. Estimated place and date of death of X-545 is in agreement with the AG casualty listing for Pvt THOMPSON.

Laundry markings and shoe size of shoes found on X-545 are not in agreement with the OQMG Form 371 for Pvt THOMPSON. However the fact that the tooth chart is in exact agreement with the tooth chart for Pvt THOMPSON overrides this contradiction. World casualty listings were checked for possible association of the laundry markings with negative results.

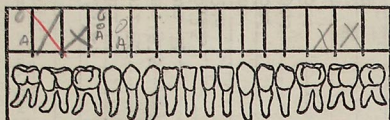
